Please have whoever is in charge of the dinner let the DJ know when it is time to eat... If requested, the DJ can announce the serving order (beginning with the Wedding Party, Parents, Grandparents) and then release each table one by one.

Traditionally after dinner, champagne is poured and the Best Man, Maid/Matron of Honor, and/or other pre-selected speakers will make a toast. When ready to do the toast please let the DJ know and he will announce for everyone to be seated and give the speaker a microphone.
